This letter is provided in response to your questions related to the Residential Treatment Facility North (RTFN) project located at 29901 80<sup>th</sup> Ave NW in Stanwood, WA. We understand the responses to these questions are important in determining the design and permitting approach for the on-site septic system design you are preparing to support the building's sewer needs.

**1. Will laundry be performed on-site or off-site?**


BCRA Response – There will be two, residential-style washer/dryer units of limited use of the residents for washing personal clothing. All sheets/towels/linens and other washable items used by the facility will be sent off-site for laundering.

**2. How will food preparation be done? Will food be cooked on-site or prepared off-site and served at the facility?**

BCRA Response – All meals will be pre-packaged and delivered to the site for re-heating. They will provide three meals a day for a maximum of 16 residents in each building.
