



As of 2014, records do not include out-of-state deliveries to Washington residents because birth certificates for states other than Washington were not available for record linkage.

Eligibility Status for Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2014




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Medicaid-Paid Deliveries by County Washington Women with Births in 2014





Number of Undocumented Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2014





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Documented Status of Washington Women With Medicaid-Paid Births in 2014
