Individuals with Medicaid-paid perinatal care includes individuals with Medicaid-paid pregnancy care claims/encounters and individuals who were enrolled in a state-contracted capitated managed care plan for at least three of the last six months before delivery. Pregnant, Medicaid-eligible individuals may receive maternity support services through the First Steps Program. For this analysis, receipt of maternity support services includes paid services received in the 270 days prior to delivery or up to 90 days after delivery. Childbirth education program visits are not included. WA State total includes a small number of individuals for whom residence county could not be determined. '-' suppressed due to small numbers or for secondary suppression.
