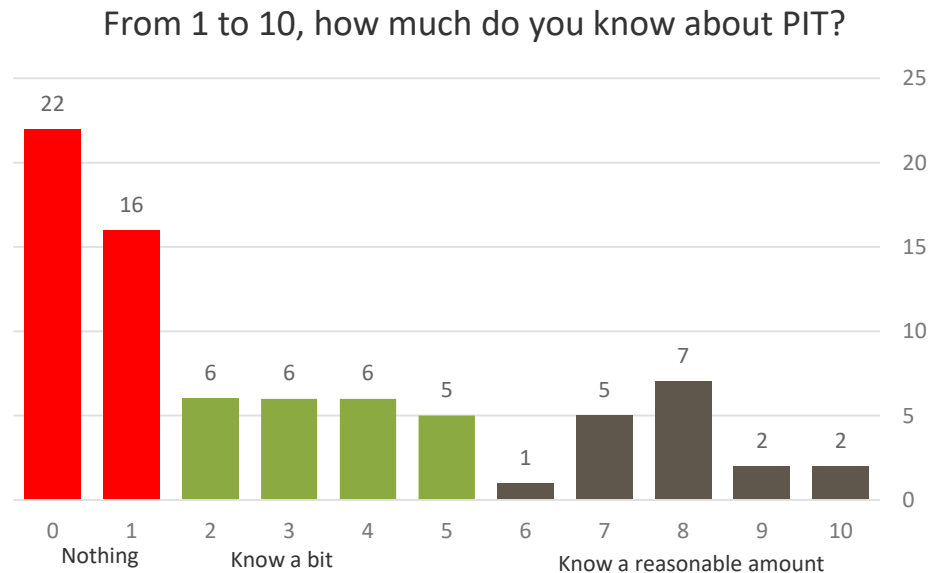

Answered: 78 Skipped: 4

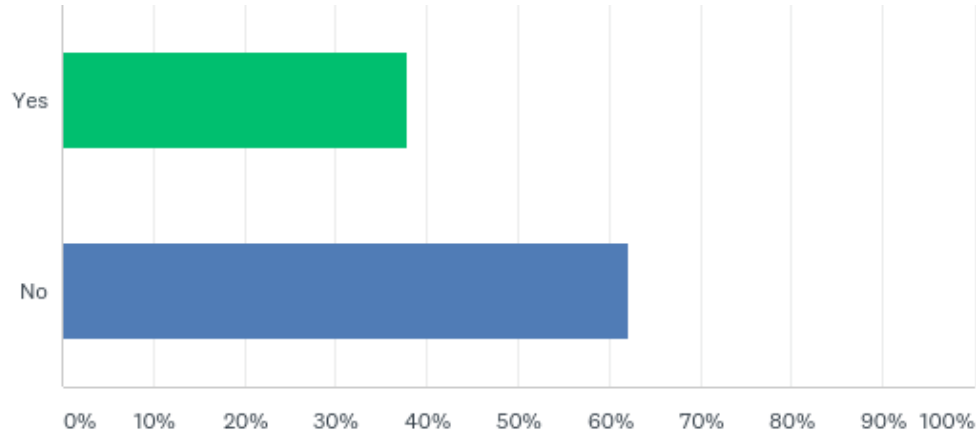

Q2: Should being commercially sexually exploited be reason enough to be committed to an inpatient psychiatric facility through the Parent Initiated Treatment process?

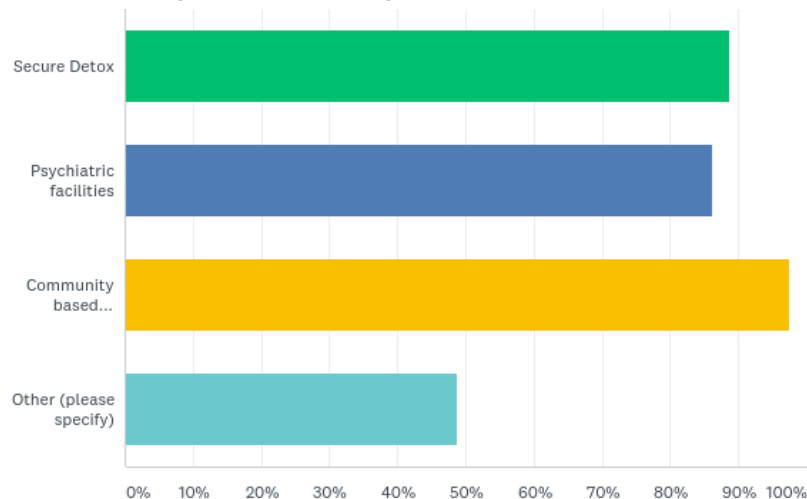

Q3: In your personal experience, which treatment services should be available for Commercially Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC)?

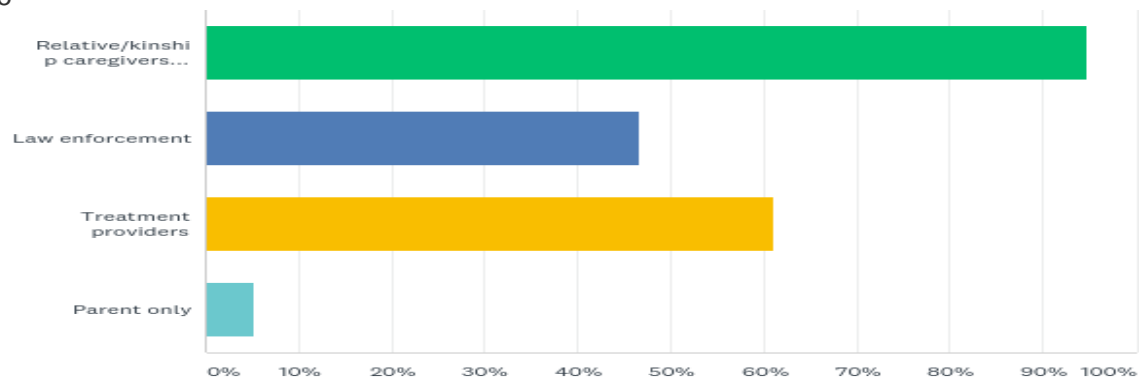
