# Changes in 2017 or 2018

1. **Potential Changes to NCQA HEDIS measures in 2018**
  - A. **Immunizations for Adolescents**
    - Allow for 2 or 3 doses of HPV
  - B. **Plan All-Cause 30-Day Readmissions**
    - Allow measure for Medicaid population
  - C. **Breast Cancer Screening**
    - Count Digital Breast Tomosynthesis (DBT) in numerator
2. **Implementation of Updated Potentially Avoidable ER Visit measure in 2017 (expanded, updated for ICD-10)**
3. **Possibility of adding Bree-recommended Opioid Prescribing Measures in 2018**

  - State, 39 counties, 9 ACHS, 190 medical groups, 700 clinics, 90 hospitals, 15 health plans
  - 90+ measures
- Powered by Tableau
- Currently co-branded with Healthier Washington
- Public website for Common Measure Set results

# Measures appropriate for value-based contracting

## Driven by:

- Availability of robust results by contracting entity
- Improvement reasonably thought to be within sphere of influence of contracting entity

2017 Common Measure Set measures appropriate for value-based contracting with **(see attachment for detail)**

Health Plans 32 Measures*		Medical Groups/Clinics of Four or More Providers 22 Measures*		Hospitals 10 Measures	
Pediatric-related	5	Pediatric-related	3		
Adult-related	27**	Adult-related	19		

*\*Some measures have multiple rates. Some measures appropriate for commercial only or Medicaid only.*

*\*\*One measure not available for implementation until 2018.*

# Measures Not Appropriate for Value-Based Contracting

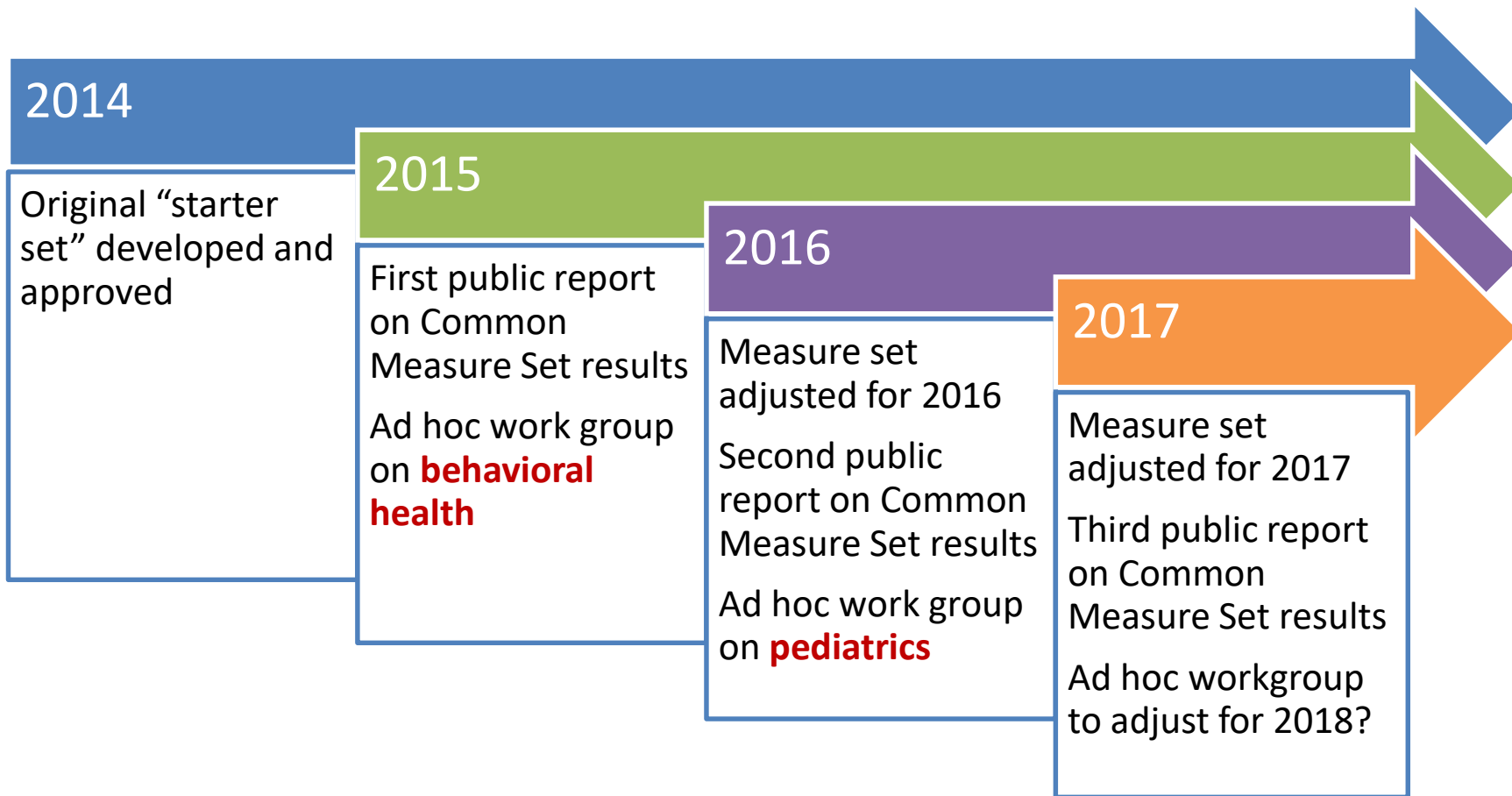
- 12 Measures **(see attachment for detail)**
  - Data collected by geographic area
  - Results not easily or reliably attributable to contracting entity
  - Some have very small cell size
- Still very worthwhile to include in the Common Measure Set
  - Geographic results (e.g., county, ACH) relevant for community health improvement

# Consider need for topic-focused, ad hoc work group in 2017





# Need for topic-focused, ad hoc-workgroup in 2017

1. Still quite limited by lack of availability of clinical data from EHR to support robust public reporting of results for these types of measures (from “parking lot”)
  - Depression screening
  - Care transitions and coordination of care
  - Control measures at the medical group level (e.g., BP, HBA1c)
  - Patient functional status
2. Consideration of adding measures needs to take into account overall size of measure set
3. Consideration of eliminating measures needs to take into account value-based contracting already underway



# Need for topic-focused, ad hoc-workgroup in 2017

Two areas to consider for adjusting Common Measure Set for 2018 implementation:

- Additional population health measures?
- Review/update hospital quality measures?
