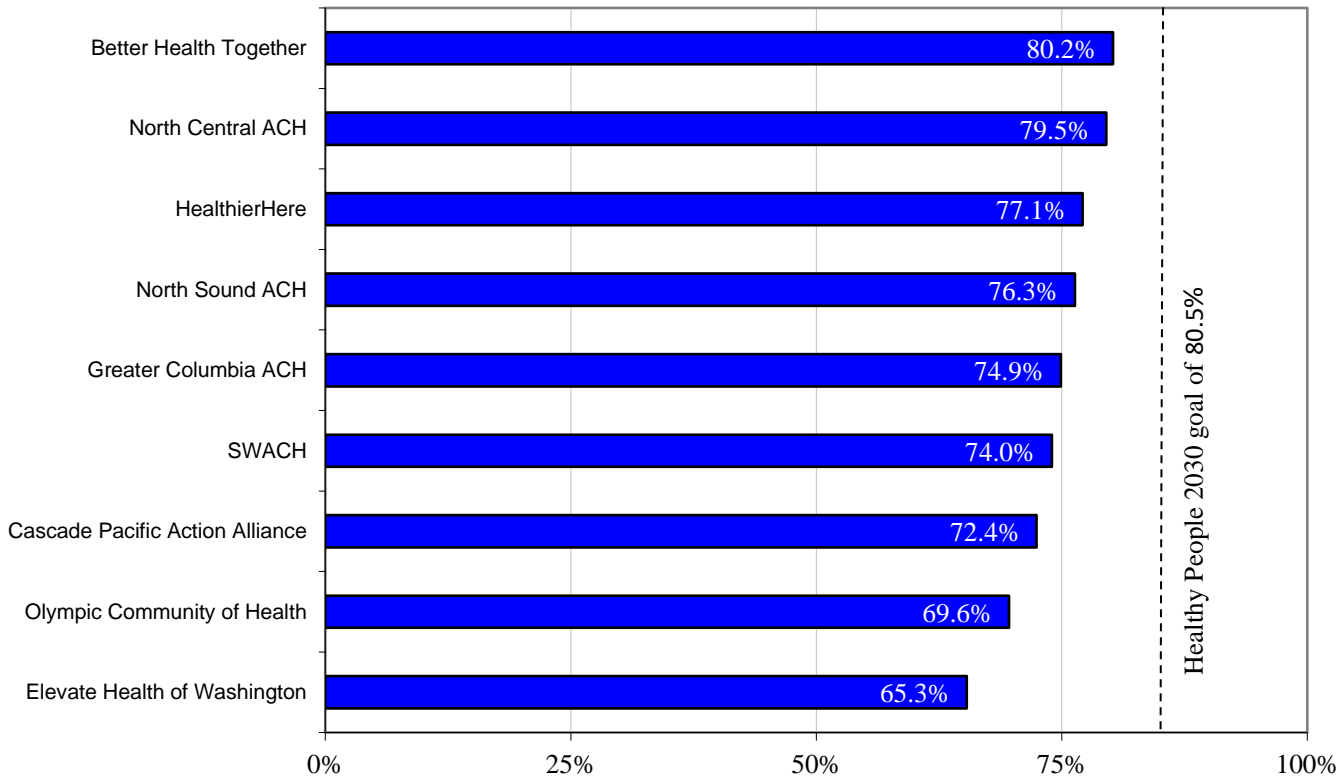

Medicaid refers to the receipt of Medicaid paid maternity care services or enrollment in a state-contracted capitated managed care plan for at least 3 of the last 6 months before delivery. Calculations for the percent of women with first trimester prenatal care (% First Trimester) are based on totals which exclude records with missing prenatal care information (10.4% of total records, with Medicaid percent missing noted in final column). The Avg. # Visits refers to the average (mean) number of prenatal care visits reported on the birth certificate. The percent difference is the difference between the percent of Medicaid women receiving first trimester prenatal care and the percent of Non Medicaid women receiving first trimester prenatal care. Positive numbers indicate a greater proportion of Medicaid women, compared to Non Medicaid women, who are receiving first trimester prenatal care. The method used to calculate Trimester Prenatal Care Began has been revised from reports produced prior to 2013 to better align with NCHS recommendations. State total includes a small number of women for whom residence ACH could not be determined.

 ACH rates are for women with Medicaid-paid maternity care.  
 Calculations for the percent of women with first trimester prenatal care are based on totals which exclude records with missing prenatal care information.  
 Plan is as of month of delivery.  
 As of 2014, records do not include out-of-state deliveries to Washington residents because birth certificates for states other than Washington
