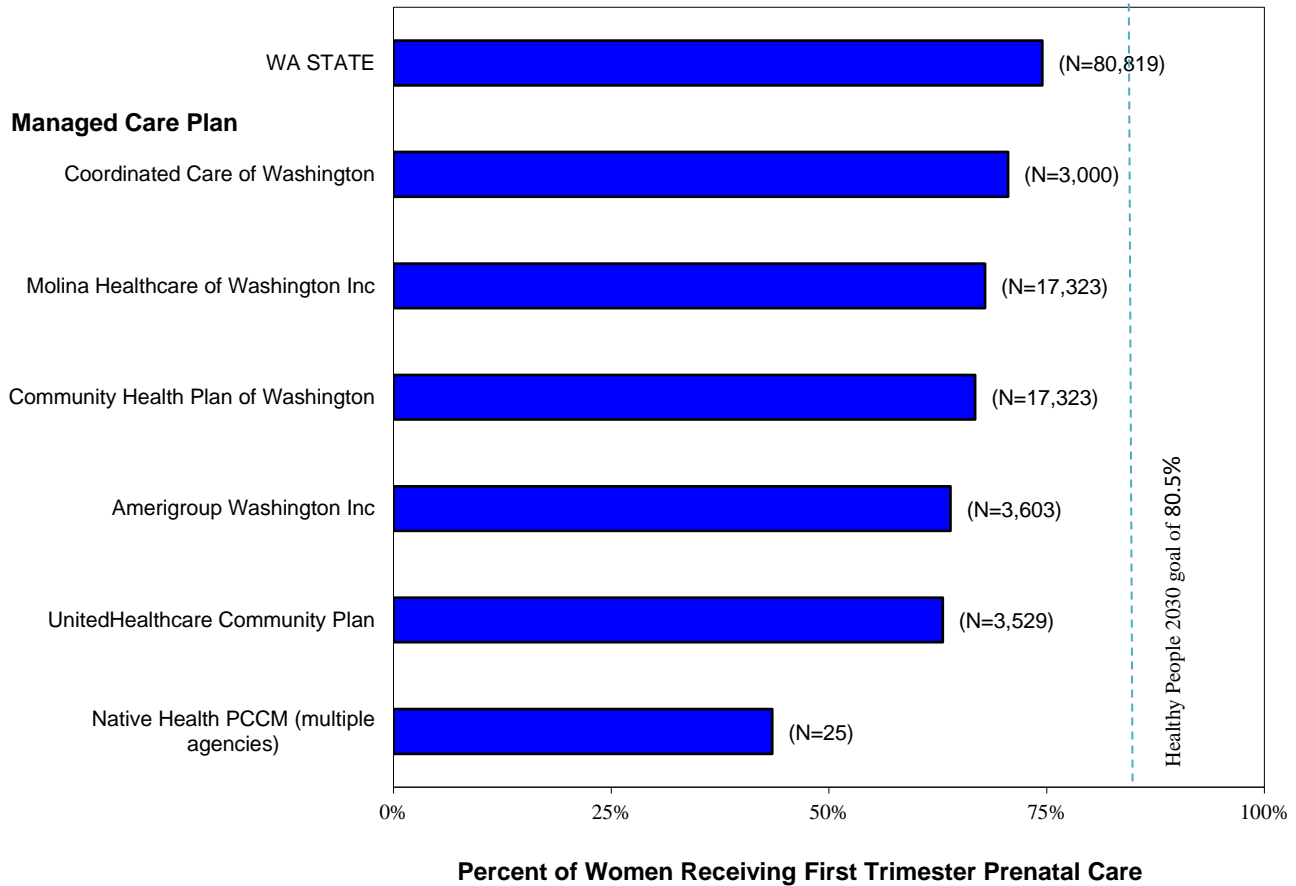

Medicaid managed care refers to a Medicaid delivery case rate payment or enrollment in a state-contracted capitated managed care plan for at least 3 of the last 6 months before delivery. The percent of women with first trimester prenatal care (% First Trimester) is the proportion of women who initiated prenatal care in the first three months of pregnancy among all women giving birth. The average number of prenatal care visits (Avg. # Visits) and the month in which prenatal care began are based on information from the Washington State birth certificate. Records with missing values have been excluded from the calculation of the percent with first trimester prenatal care. The method used to calculate Trimester Prenatal Care Began has been revised from reports produced prior to 2013 to better align with NCHS recommendations. As of 2014, records do not include out-of-state deliveries to Washington residents because birth certificates for states other than Washington were not available for record linkage. Plan is as of month of delivery.

"WASHINGTON STATE" includes all Washington women with deliveries for the year, regardless of Medicaid status. Calculations for the percent of women with first trimester prenatal care are based on totals which exclude records with missing prenatal care information. Plan is as of month of delivery. As of 2014, records do not include out-of-state deliveries to Washington residents because birth certificates for states other than Washington were not available for record linkage.
