2)	N/A (General Question)	N/A	I am looking for a list of allowable and unallowable expenses for this funding opportunity. Specifically, we are wondering if funds can be used to pay students a stipend to participate in a focus group or steering committee, to incentivize students to participate in the planning process, and help us gain access to their unique understanding of and experience with the issues around youth gambling.	There are no restrictions on using funding to provide student stipends or incentives.
