# Program Overview

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- ▶ The Recovery Navigator Program is statewide, active in every one of Washington's 39 counties.
- ▶ RNP is a peer-led program, centering lived experience in staffing to provide system navigation to treatment and supportive services using harm reduction and peer-supported guidance.
- ▶ Data collection allows the program to:
  - ▶ Understand who is served
  - ▶ What services are provided
  - ▶ What outcomes are achieved

# Why These Updates Were Developed

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- ▶ Ongoing data and process improvement efforts have been underway for some time.
- ▶ An Internal data workgroup has met regularly to:
  - ▶ Review and process gathered feedback from SURSAC, Behavioral Health Administrative Service Organizations, LEAD Support Bureau, and providers.
  - ▶ Conduct process improvement efforts including data modeling, research and analysis among various other community programs, and contracting for review and analysis with DSHS Research and Data Analysis Team.
- ▶ Earlier versions lacked supporting guidance, leading to variation in interpretation.
- ▶ Updates reflect collaboration and lessons learned over time.

# What Changed

- ▶ What's new at a glance:
  - ▶ Clearer distinction between outreach, referrals, and ongoing navigation.
  - ▶ Improved tracking of client progress over time.
  - ▶ Shared definitions used across programs.
  - ▶ Streamlining reporting to support statewide analysis.

# Improved Outcome Reporting

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- ▶ Stronger Understanding of Client Outcomes.
- ▶ Programs can now more clearly report outcomes such as:
  - ▶ Engagement in treatment or services
  - ▶ Progress toward stable housing
  - ▶ Transitions to other supports or programs
  - ▶ Continued navigation with additional assistance is needed.

# Supporting Providers & Navigators

- ▶ Updates were designed to reflect how work occurs in practice.
- ▶ New guidance supports consistent interpretation statewide.
- ▶ Support tools will include:
  - ▶ Data Definitions Field Guide
  - ▶ A Desk Manual for workbook use.





# Why This Matters

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- ▶ Improved data quality strengthens:
  - ▶ Public Reporting
  - ▶ Program Oversight
  - ▶ Consistent statewide data
- ▶ These updates demonstrate a commitment to continuous improvement, collaboration with communities and provider, and provide a clear and more reliable reporting of program data and outcomes.

# Training & Implementation

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- ▶ Statewide Provider training will take place on January 13, 2026, for BH-ASOs and RNP Providers.
- ▶ Training will focus on:
  - ▶ Overview of Workbook Changes
  - ▶ Purpose of the updates
  - ▶ How outcomes are captured
  - ▶ Use of supporting guidance materials
- ▶ Implementation of the new workbook will start Quarter 2 of 2026, April 1, 2026.
