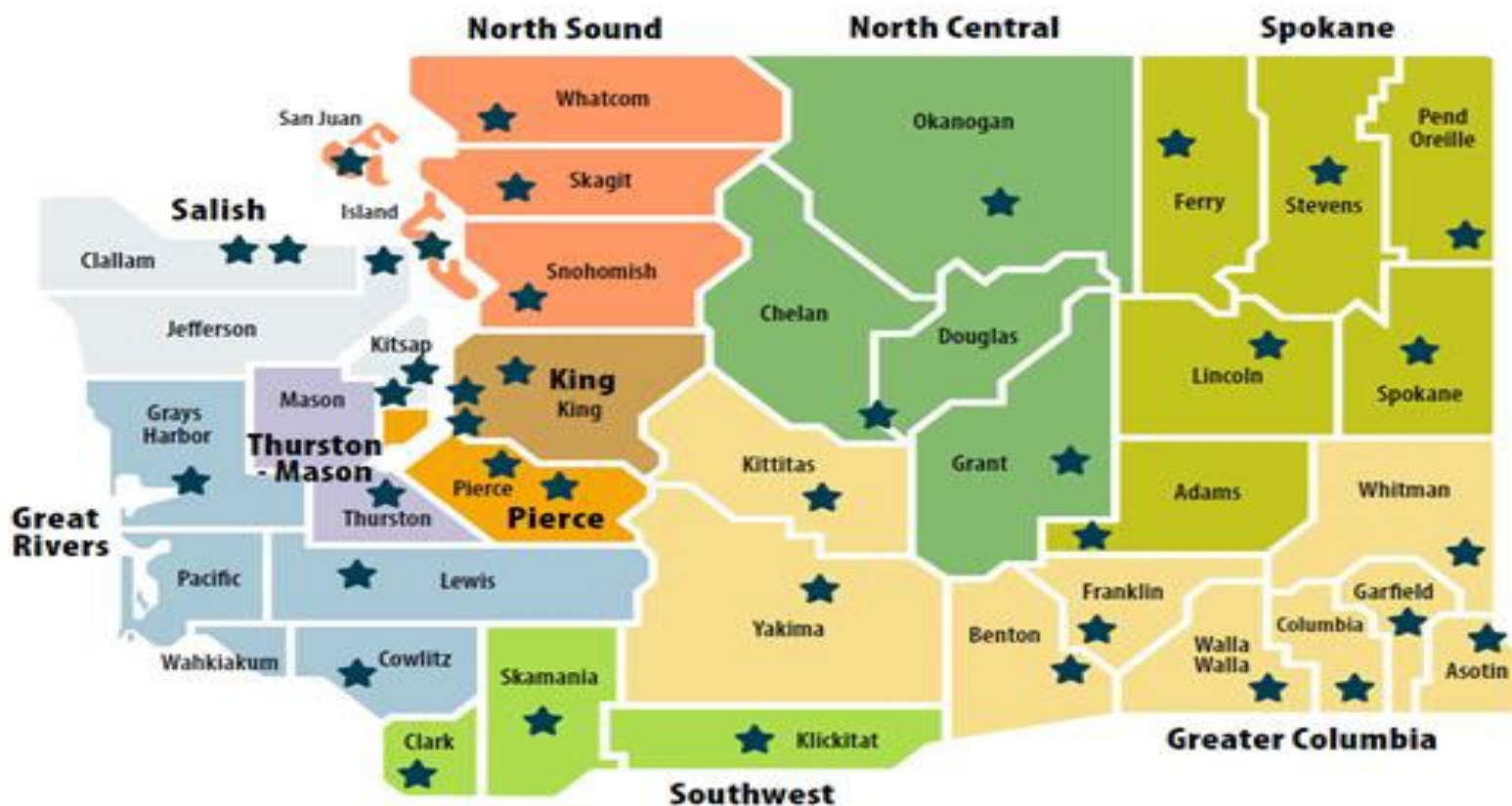

What is RNP?

- ▶ The Recovery Navigator Program (RNP) is a statewide diversion effort serving individuals who intersect with law enforcement and/or people who have frequent criminal legal system contact because of unmet behavioral health needs.
 - ▶ Statewide, active in every one of Washington's 39 counties.
 - ▶ Peer-led program, centering lived experience in staffing and hiring
 - ▶ Partnerships with the regional BH-ASOs
- ▶ RNP staff work with local community resources to address the intersectional and holistic needs of the individual by addressing the social determinants of health, including education, housing, and employment.

There are Recovery Navigator Programs in every county across the state. Some areas with less density are supported by neighboring counties, and some higher population centers have more than one provider

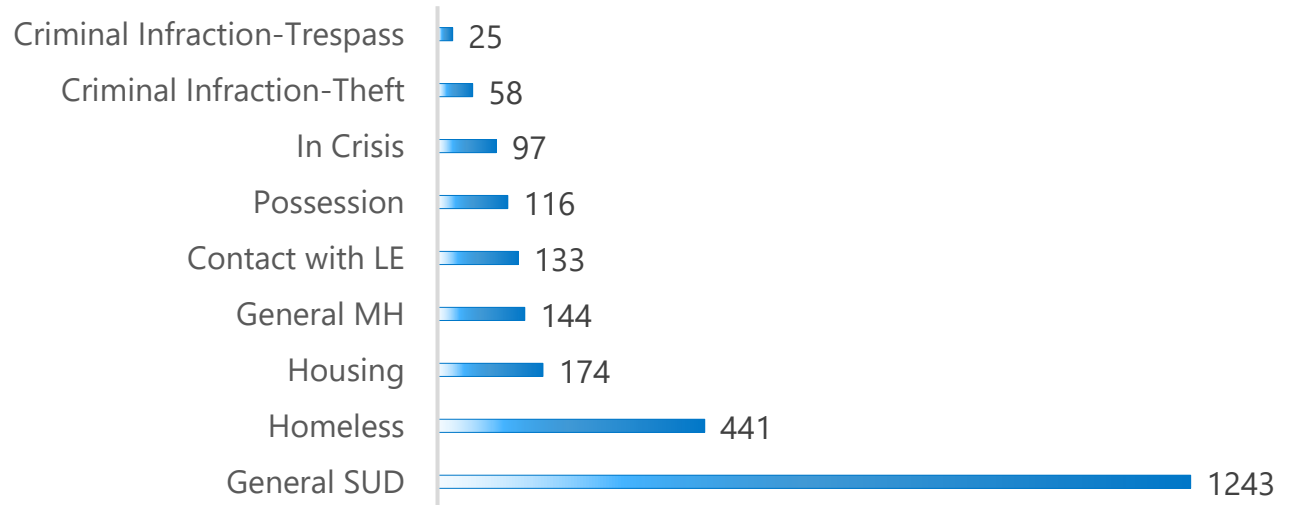

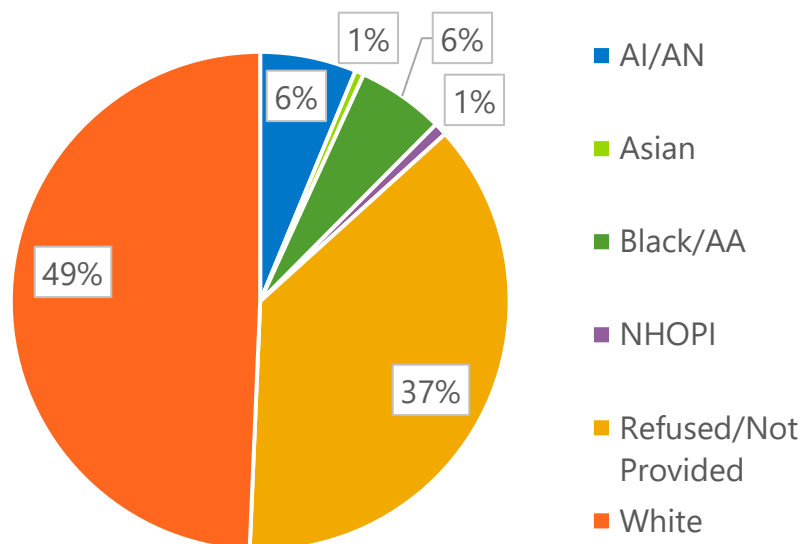

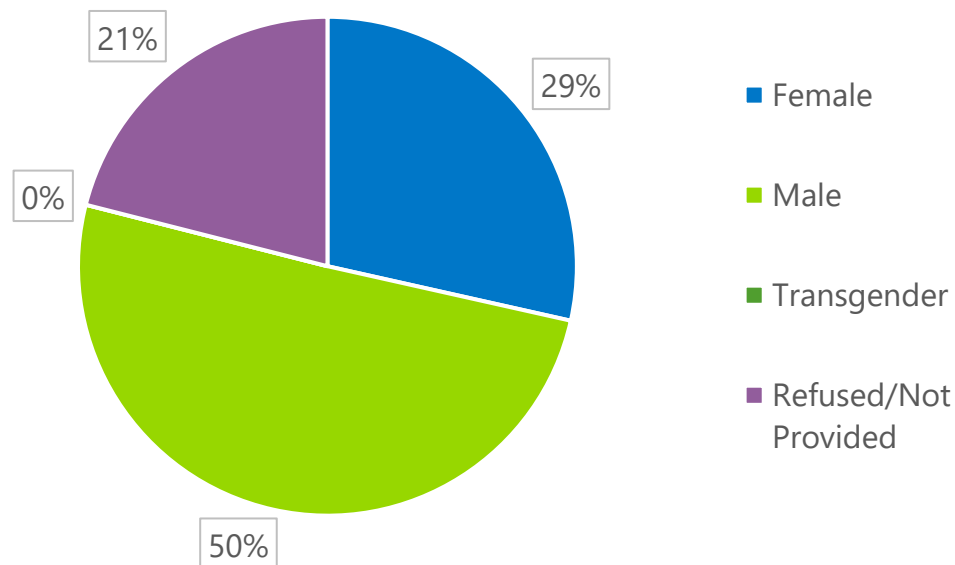

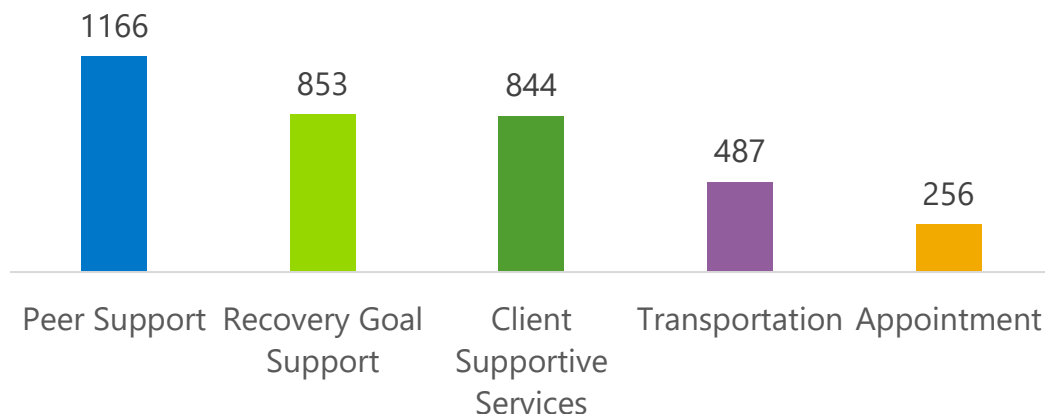

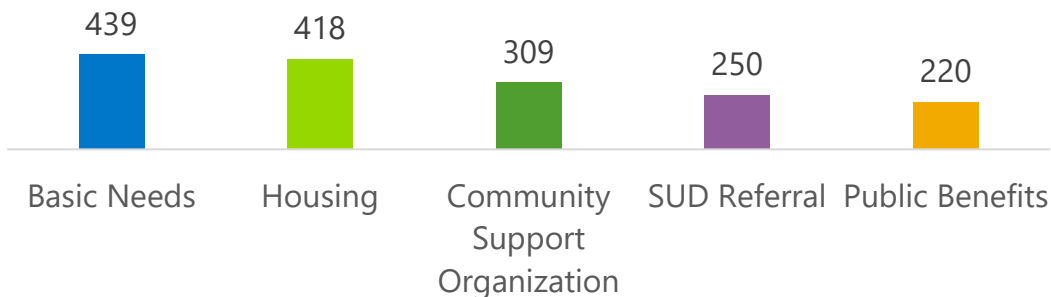

Top 5 Direct Care Services



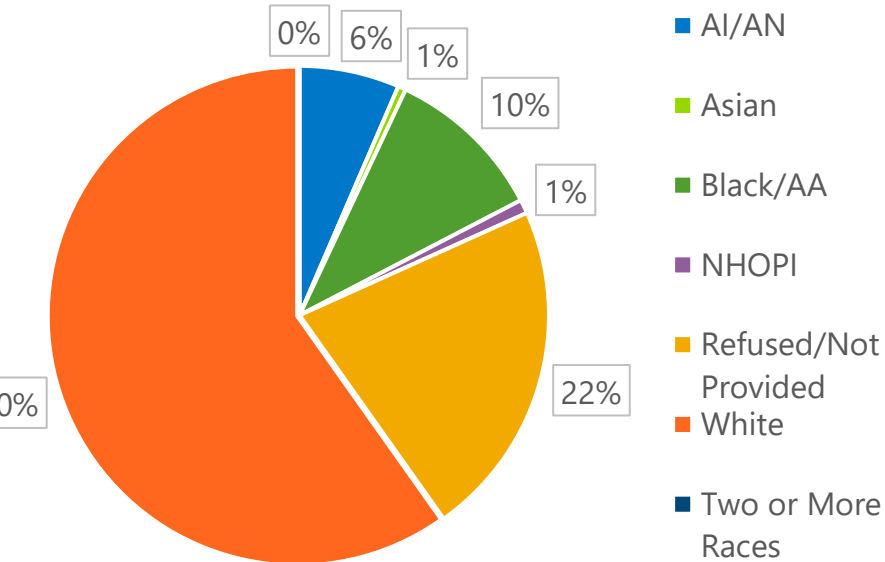
Top 5 Referrals to Services



Case Management Demographic Data Q1

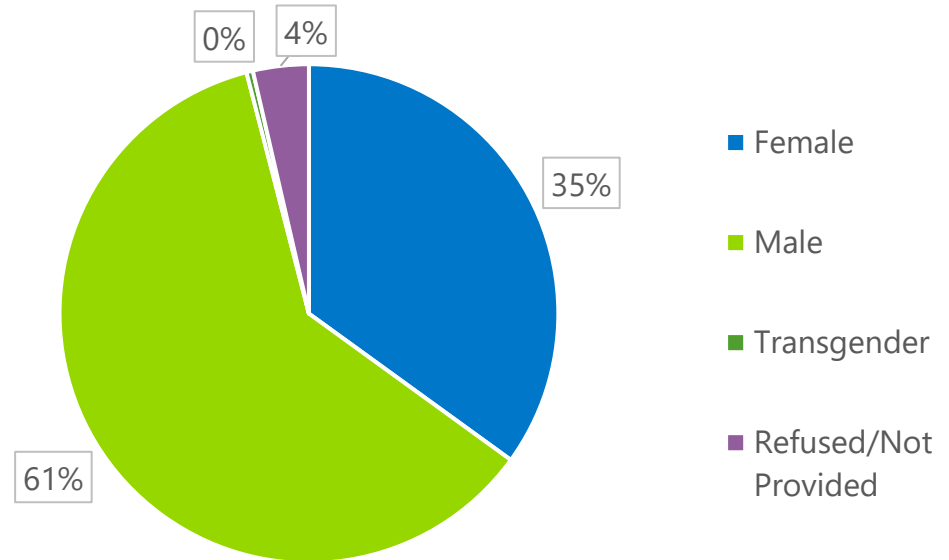
