Dr. Barry is a champion of shared decision making between patients and clinicians. Dr. Barry is a past president of the Society for Medical Decision Making and the Society of General Internal Medicine. He served as Chief Science Officer at Healthwise and was president of the Informed Medical Decisions Foundation. He is a Master of the American College of Physicians (ACP). In 2020, he won the ACP's Henry D. Bruce Memorial Award for Distinguished Contributions to Preventive Medicine. He previously served as chief of the General Medicine Unit at MGH. He has participated in clinical practice

Dr. Barry also served as a member, vice chair and chair of the U.S. Preventive Services Task Force from 2017-2024. He practiced adult primary care at MGH for over 40 years.
