With dual training in medicine and law, she leads efforts to empower thousands of patients and families across the country with culturally attuned, evidence-based video tools that support informed, values-based medical decisions. Under her leadership, ACP Decisions helps organizations and clinicians embed dignity, clarity, and

			compassion into care—especially at life's most pivotal moments—ensuring that every voice is heard and honored. Angelo Volandes, MD, MPH, is a physician, researcher, and Professor of Medicine at the Geisel School of Medicine at Dartmouth, where he also serves as Vice Chair for Research at Dartmouth Health. He is President and Co-Founder of ACP Decisions, a nonprofit foundation advancing shared decision-making through multilingual, evidence-based video tools. Prior to joining Dartmouth, Dr. Volandes spent two decades on the faculty at Massachusetts General Hospital and Harvard Medical School, where he helped shape innovations in patient-centered care and health communication.
