She is an Associate Professor of Obstetrics & Gynecology and Adjunct Associate Professor of Health Systems and Population Health at the University of Washington. Her research focuses on identifying gaps in quality and equity of reproductive health care at the VA and developing and

Implementing a	15 minutes		testing interventions to promote patient-centered counseling and care and shared decision making. As a VA gynecologist, she maintains an active clinical practice, and teaches residents. Daniel Matlock, MD Dr. Matlock is the Director of the Colorado Program for Patient Centered Decisions at ACCORDS (The Adult and Child Consortium for Outcomes Research and Delivery Science). He is board certified in Internal Medicine, Geriatrics, and Palliative care and is Vice Chair for health services research. His research is aimed at fundamentally changing and improving how patients make major, fateful medical decisions. He has been funded under an NIH career development award, several NHLBI, NIA, and NCI RO1s (two Co-I, one PI), and four PCORI projects studying shared decision making among older adults making decisions around invasive technologies. He has participated in the American College of Cardiology's shared decision making task force and he is also an active participant of the International Patient Decision Aid Standards writing committee. Recently, he has also been named Associate Director of Clinical Innovation at the Denver Veterans Affairs Geriatric Research, Education, and Clinical Center.
