- High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area
- Mission: Reduce drug trafficking and misuse through collaboration
- Grant program for public safety, prevention, and treatment
- Created by Congress
- Overseen by the Office of National Drug Control Policy under the Executive Office of the President

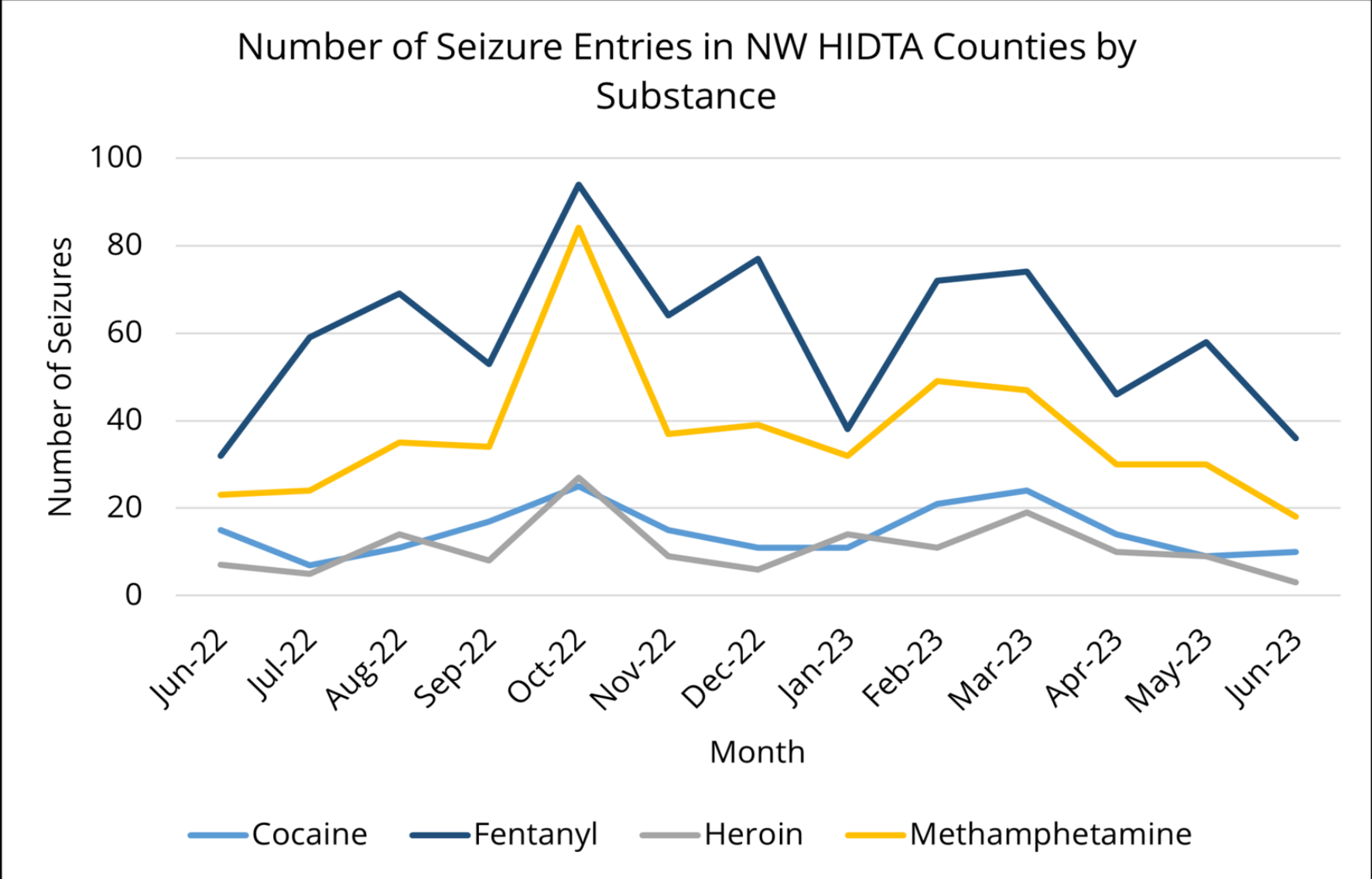


# About the data: Northwest HIDTA

- Federal, state, Tribal, and local law enforcement task forces
- 15 counties (but 90% of WA population)
- Seizure numbers reported quarterly

# Trends Identified

- Continued increase in fentanyl powder
  - Fentanyl pills and powder often reported in same seizure
- Cocaine increase in Eastern Washington
- Continued decrease in heroin
- Methamphetamine relatively stable
- Xylazine rates still low in most places
- Potential benzodiazepine increase in some areas (preliminary trend)
