				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Foundational Community Support Services related to supportive housing and employment was again renewed. • In addition – for the first time as part of the new waiver, six-month rental subsidies were included. • Committed to working with CMS on a framework for health equity. • Re-Entry: Fortunately, in Washington we have an almost real-time suspension program for Medicaid coverage for incarcerated individuals. • We have some system delays for 24 or 48 hours and then on the prison side we have some other delays in terms of getting people assigned to managed care plans. But we are working on that. • Part of the federal approvals is to improve that suspension program. • We can deliver services in several settings up to 90-days prior to release. • CMS was able to develop a framework that really gives states instructions on how to apply between now and the 1115 Waiver for these re-entry services. Our vision here is a more integrated system particularly for the care coordination transition of services in the community and particularly for behavioral health needs. For example, medication for
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				<p>substance use disorders.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The population here is the Medicaid eligible population, 90-days prior to their release. They will be covered by what is a limited set of services. • CMS requires a 30-day supply of medicine before release. That is a requirement of serving our members and a waiver approval requirement. • We need to develop a system to ensure that a local jail that is compliant and ready for the services, are also ready to supply medication, not just a script when somebody leaves the setting. We will have to develop programming for that. • Secondary services; behavioral health evaluation management codes, screening particularly and some targeted treatment, lab and radiology, and all other drugs in terms of a pharmacy availability. • There will be a few other areas such as HIV, AIDS, Hepatitis C, we could do some evaluation treatment for targeted conditions along those lines. •
