They will be covered by what is a limited set of services.</li> <li>CMS requires a 30-day supply of medicine before release. That is a requirement of serving our members and a waiver approval requirement.</li> <li>We need to develop a system to ensure that a local jail that is compliant and ready for the services, are also ready to supply medication, not just a script when somebody leaves the setting. We will have to develop programming for that.</li> <li>Secondary services; behavioral health evaluation management codes, screening particularly and some targeted treatment, lab and radiology, and all other drugs in terms of a pharmacy availability.</li> <li>There will be a few other areas such as HIV, AIDS, Hepatitis C, we could do some evaluation treatment for targeted conditions along those lines.</li> </ul>
