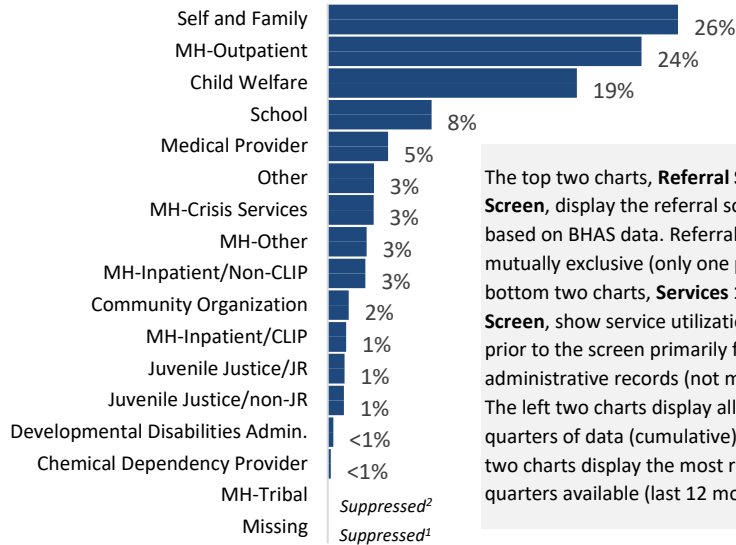

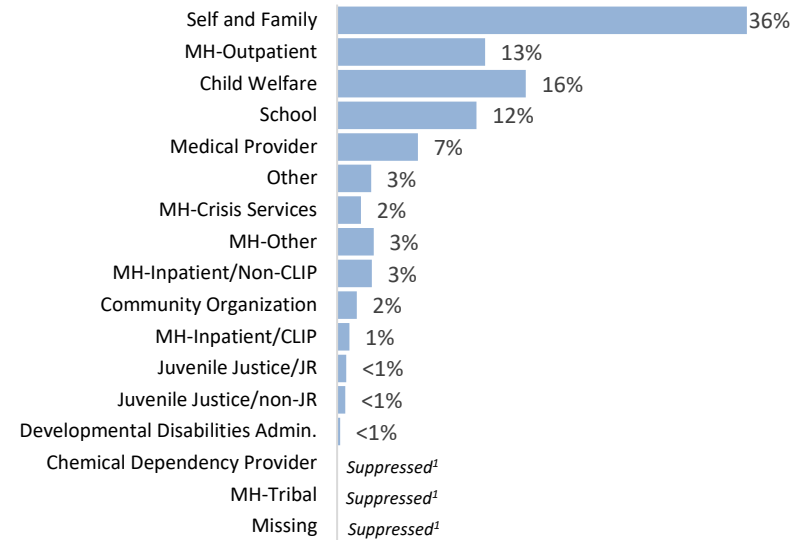

The left two charts display all available quarters of data (cumulative), and the right two charts display the most recent four quarters available (last 12 months).

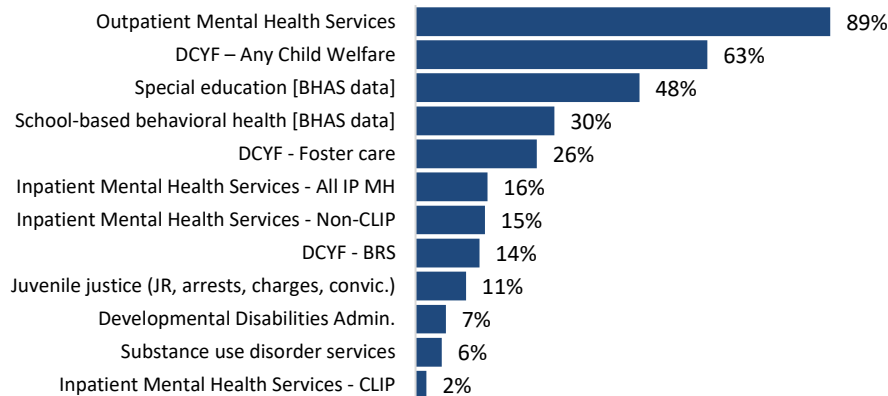
LAST 12 MONTHS October 2021 - September 2022



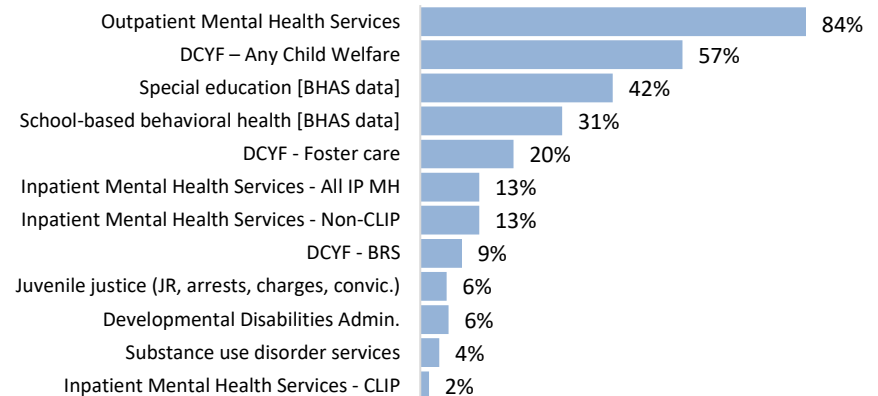

LAST 12 MONTHS July 2021 - June 2022

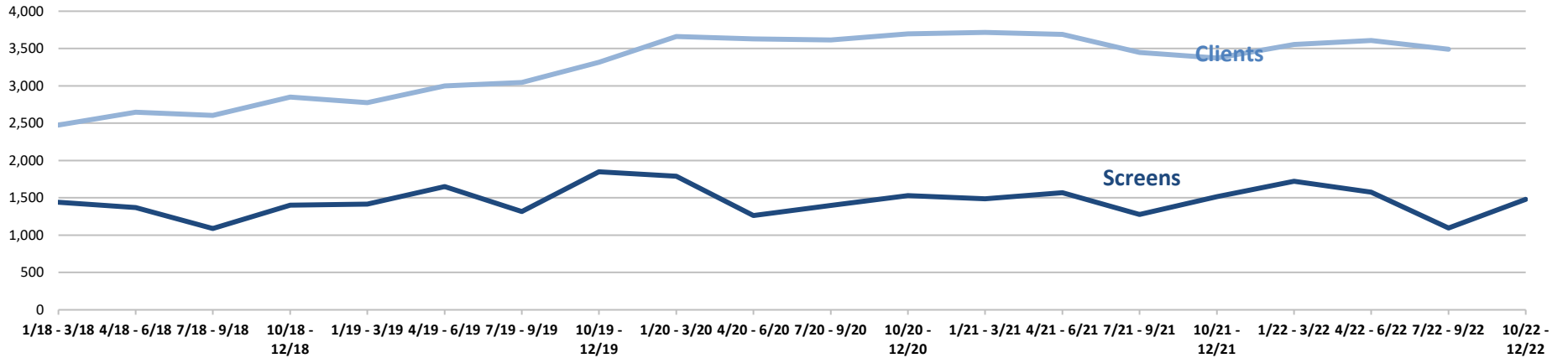
