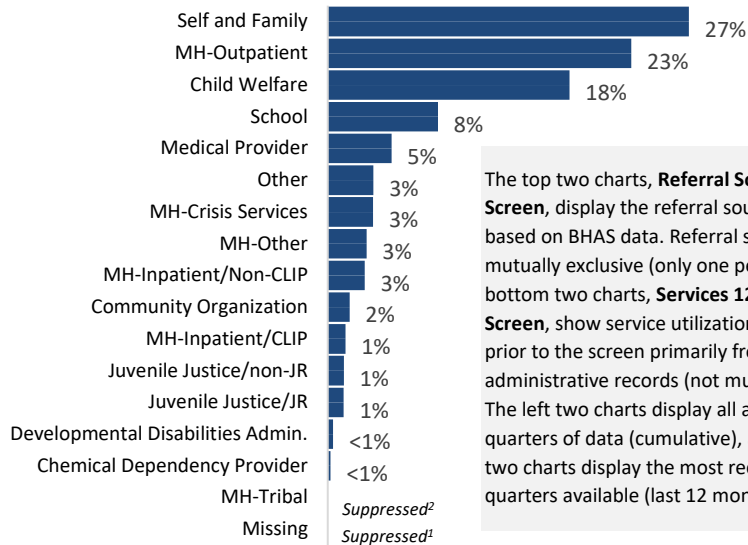

### Referral Source for WISe Screen

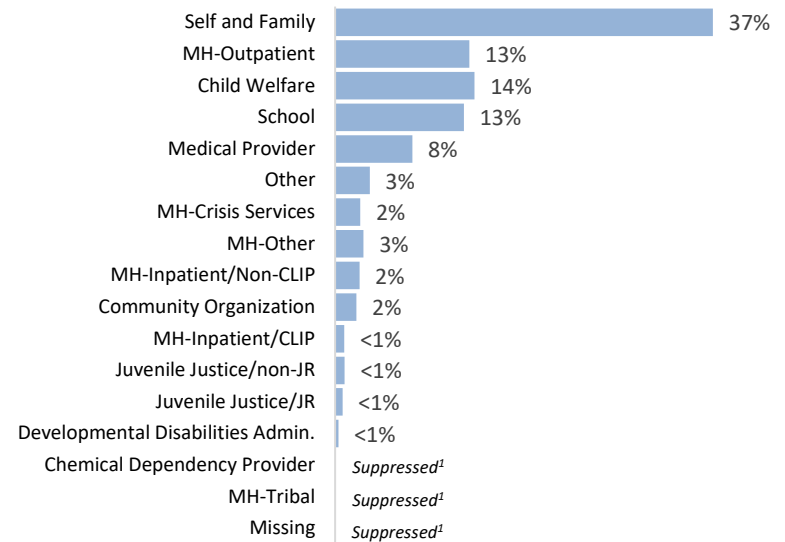

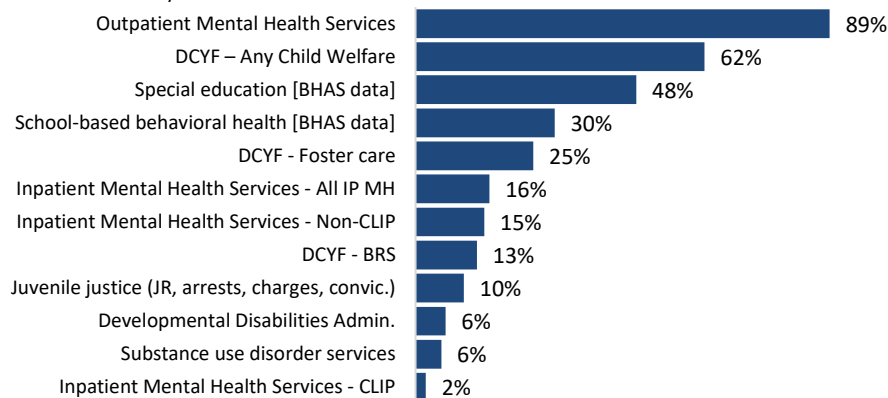
**LAST 12 MONTHS** July 2022 - June 2023



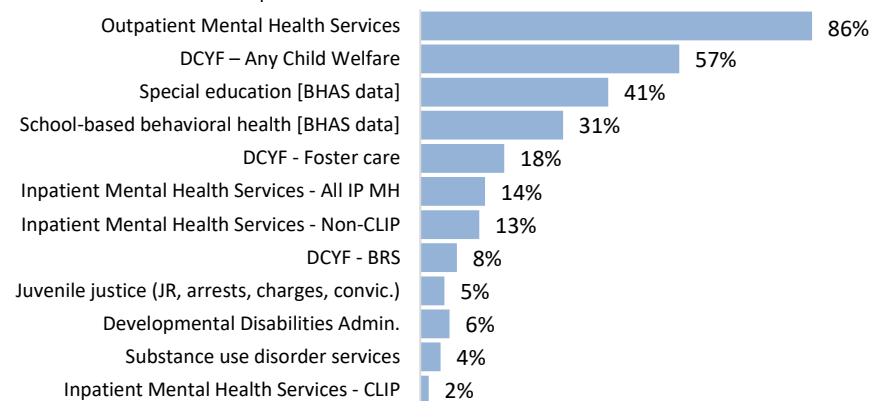
### Services 12 Months Before Screen

**LAST 12 MONTHS** April 2022 - March 2023

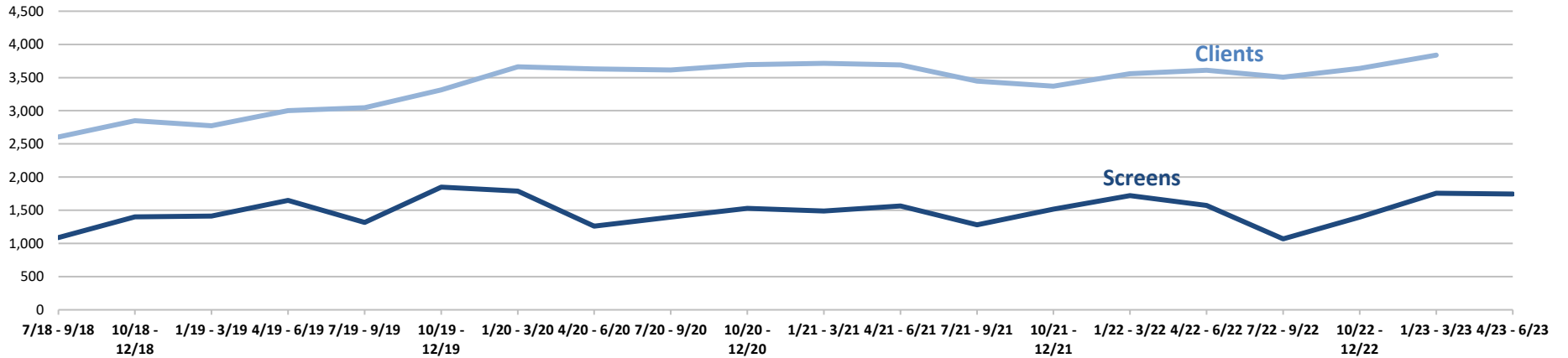
