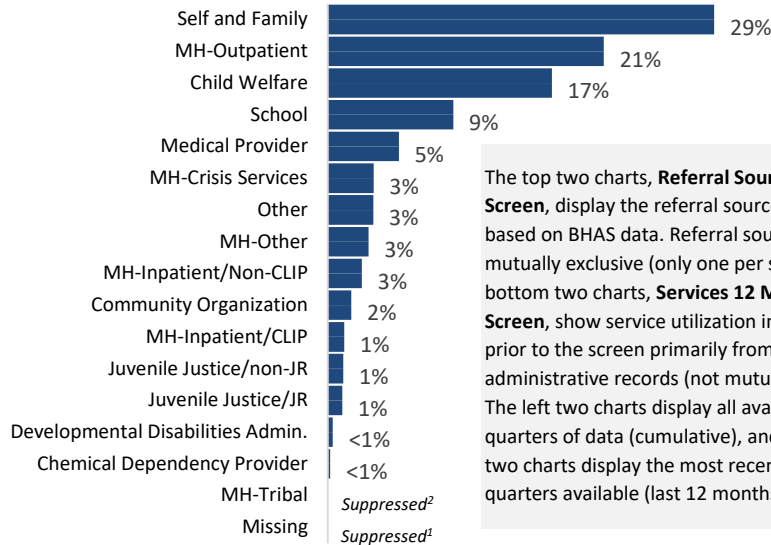

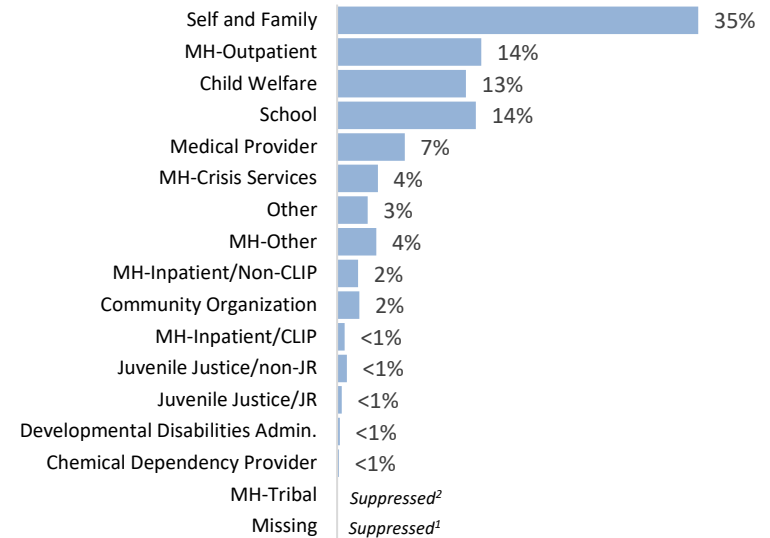

The left two charts display all available quarters of data (cumulative), and the right two charts display the most recent four quarters available (last 12 months).

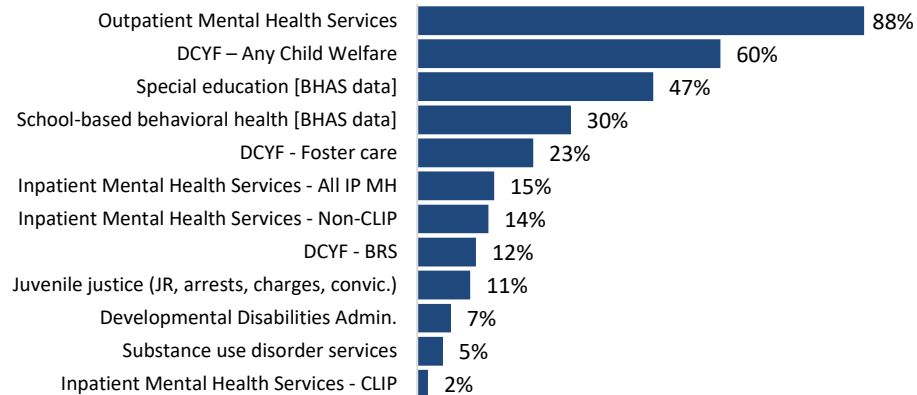
LAST 12 MONTHS April 2024 - March 2025



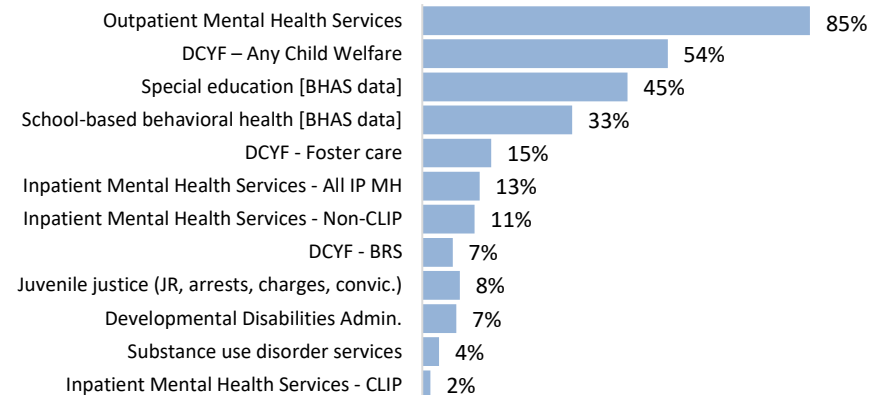
Services 12 Months Before Screen

LAST 12 MONTHS January 2024 - December 2024

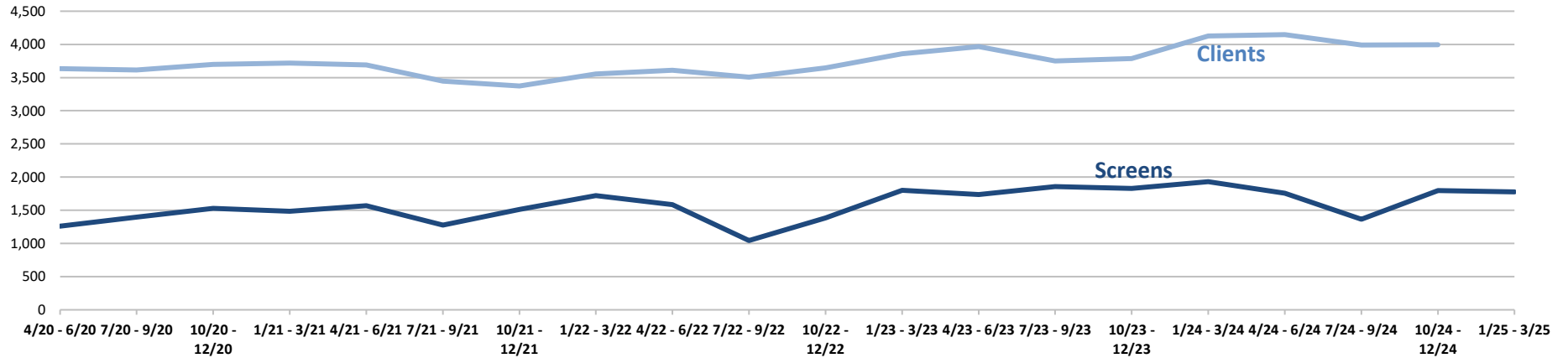
