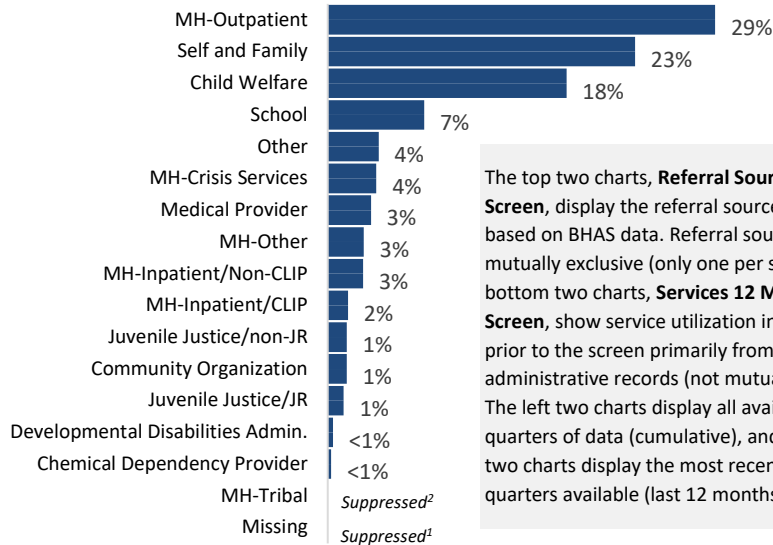

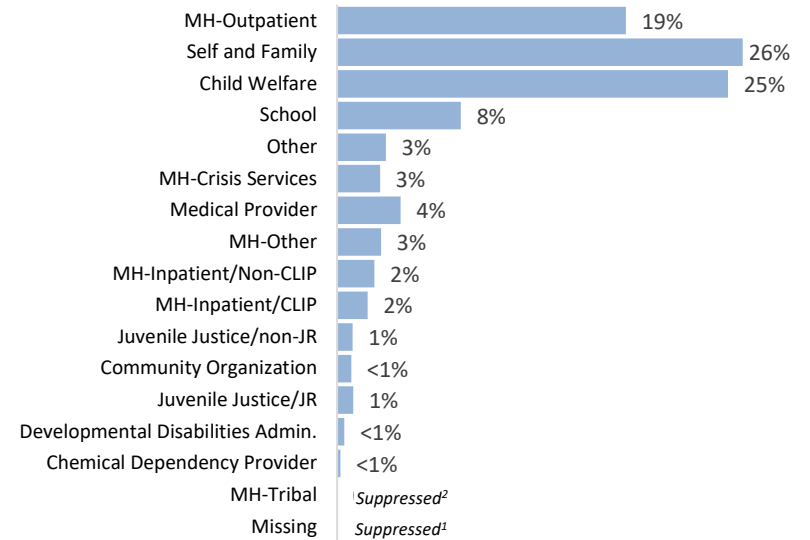

LAST 12 MONTHS July 2019 - June 2020

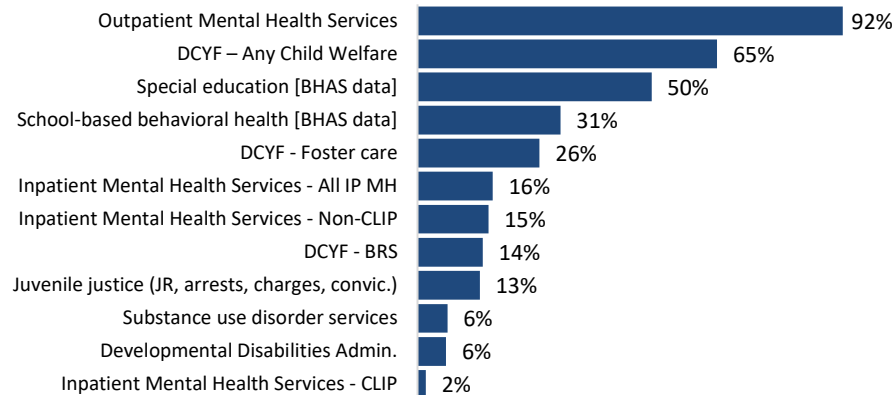


The top two charts, **Referral Sources for WISe Screen**, display the referral sources for screens based on BHAS data. Referral sources are mutually exclusive (only one per screen). The left two charts display all available quarters of data (cumulative), and the right two charts display the most recent four quarters available (last 12 months).

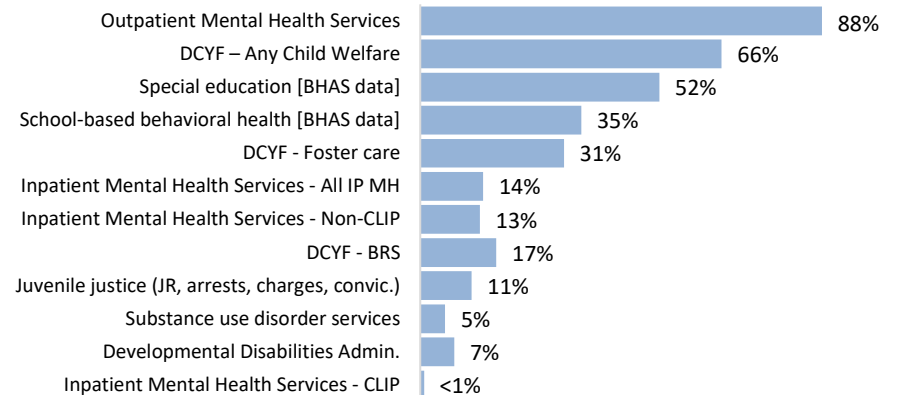
Services 12 Months Before Screen

LAST 12 MONTHS April 2019 - March 2020

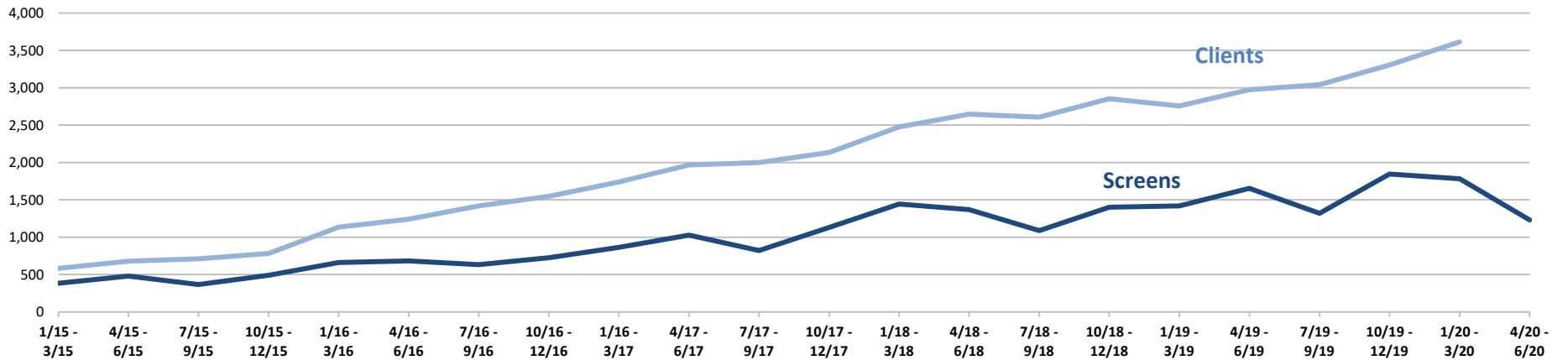
