ELIGIBILITY

This report provides a month-by-month look at Medicaid clients enrolled in the Foundational Community Supports (FCS) Supported Employment program, which began (along with the FCS Supportive Housing program) in January 2018.

Eligibility for Supported Employment. Medicaid clients age 16 years or older who: 1) have a mental health or substance use treatment need, or 2) are receiving long-term services AND meet one of the following criteria at the time of referral:

- Are referred to the Housing and Essential Needs program or enrolled in the Aged, Blind and Disabled program.
- Experienced multiple episodes of inpatient substance use treatment over the past two years.
- Engage in behaviors that may result in expulsion from school or termination from employment that can be attributed to a behavioral health condition.
- Are unable to find and maintain employment due to age, physical disability, or traumatic brain injury.

IIGHLIGHT

As of July 2018...

- 818 clients were currently enrolled, while 834 clients had been enrolled at least one month during the life of the program.
- The majority (83%) of enrollees were from two Medicaid Eligibility Groups: CN Blind/Disabled (38.8%) and ACA Expansion Adults (44.1%).
- Of the 818 Supported Employment enrollees, 3.3% (27 clients) were also enrolled in the FCS Supportive Housing program.

- CARE Assessment. Has had a CARE Assessment within the past 15 months.
- Mental Health Services. Has received inpatient or outpatient mental health services within the past year.
- Substance Use Disorder Services. Has received substance use disorder services (including inpatient, outpatient or opiate substitution) within the past year.
- Housing and Essential Needs Qualified. Eligible for the Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) program during the month.
- HUD Homeless Criteria. Recently homeless (during the past year) or chronically homeless (within the past three years).
- **PRISM risk score.** A risk score of 1.5 means the person's future medical expenditures are expected to be 50% higher than an average SSI disabled person.
- Serious Mental Illness. Any psychiatric diagnosis codes categorized as high, medium, or medium-low risk by the Chronic Illness and Disability Payment System (CDPS) algorithm within the past 15 months.
- Mental Health Treatment Need Flag. An indication of MH Treatment Need based on any mental health diagnosis, prescription or service recorded in administrative data within the past two years.
- Substance Use Disorder Treatment Need Flag. An indication of SUD Treatment Need based on at least one substance-related diagnosis, procedure, prescription, treatment or arrest within the past two years.
