Washington State's Foundational Community Supports Program SUPPORTIVE HOUSING

This report provides a month-by-month look at Medicaid clients enrolled in the Foundational Community Supports (FCS) Supportive Housing program, which began (along with the FCS Supported Employment program) in January 2018.

Eligibility for Supportive Housing. Medicaid clients age 18 years or older who: 1) have a mental health or substance use treatment need, 2) are receiving long-term services, or 3) have a complex physical disability AND meet one of the following criteria at the time of referral:

- Chronically homeless, as defined by the U.S. Housing and Urban Development.
- Had more than one contact with, or a stay longer than 90 days in, a correctional facility, inpatient treatment setting, hospital, skilled nursing facility, or other institutional setting in the past 12 months.
- Have a history of frequent or lengthy adult residential care facility stays.
- Had three or more different in-home caregiver providers in the last 12 months.
- Have a PRISM Risk Score of 1.5 or above.

As of July 2018...

- 388 clients were currently enrolled, while 400 clients had been enrolled at least one month during the life of the program.
- The majority (84%) of enrollees were from two Medicaid Eligibility Groups: CN Blind/Disabled (38.9%) and ACA Expansion Adults (44.8%).
- Of the 388 Supportive Housing enrollees, 7.0% (27 clients) were also enrolled in the FCS Supported Employment program.

As of July 2018...

- 26% of enrollees met the HUD Homeless criteria (recent or chronic homelessness).
- 79% of enrollees had a Serious Mental Illness related diagnosis in the previous 15 months.
- 97% of enrollees were flagged for Mental Health treatment need in the previous two years.

- CARE Assessment. Has had a CARE Assessment within the past 15 months.
- Mental Health Services. Has received inpatient or outpatient mental health services within the past year.
- Substance Use Disorder Services. Has received substance use disorder services (including inpatient, outpatient or opiate substitution) within the past year.
- Housing and Essential Needs Qualified. Eligible for the Housing and Essential Needs (HEN) program during the month.
- HUD Homeless Criteria. Recently homeless (during the past year) or chronically homeless (within the past three years).
- **PRISM risk score.** A risk score of 1.5 means the person's future medical expenditures are expected to be 50% higher than an average SSI disabled person.
- Serious Mental Illness. Any psychiatric diagnosis codes categorized as high, medium, or medium-low risk by the Chronic Illness and Disability Payment System (CDPS) algorithm within the past 15 months.
- Mental Health Treatment Need Flag. An indication of MH Treatment Need based on any mental health diagnosis, prescription or service recorded in administrative data within the past two years.
- Substance Use Disorder Treatment Need Flag. An indication of SUD Treatment Need based on at least one substance-related diagnosis, procedure, prescription, treatment or arrest within the past two years.
