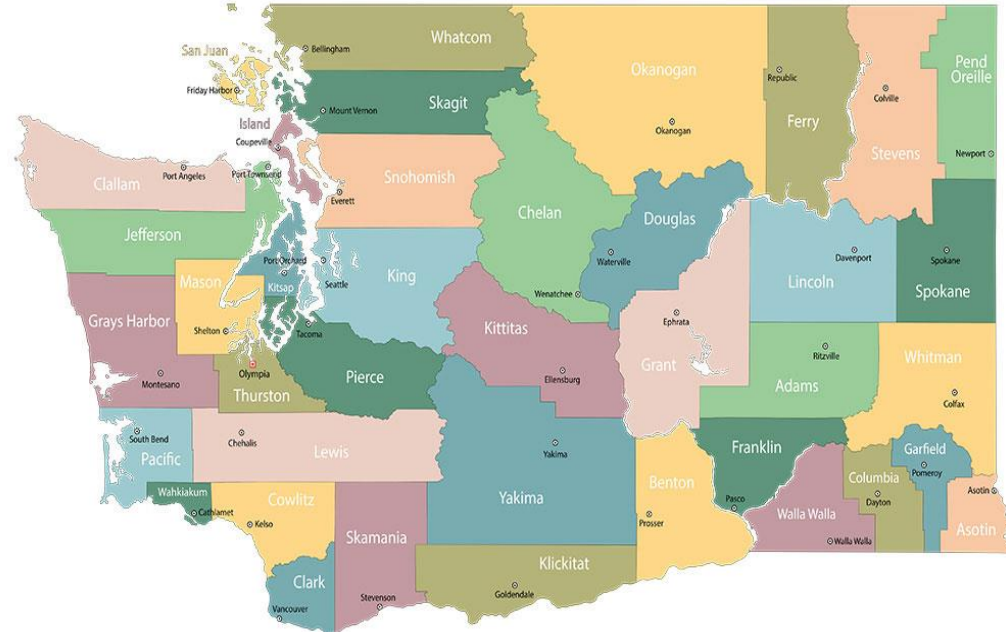

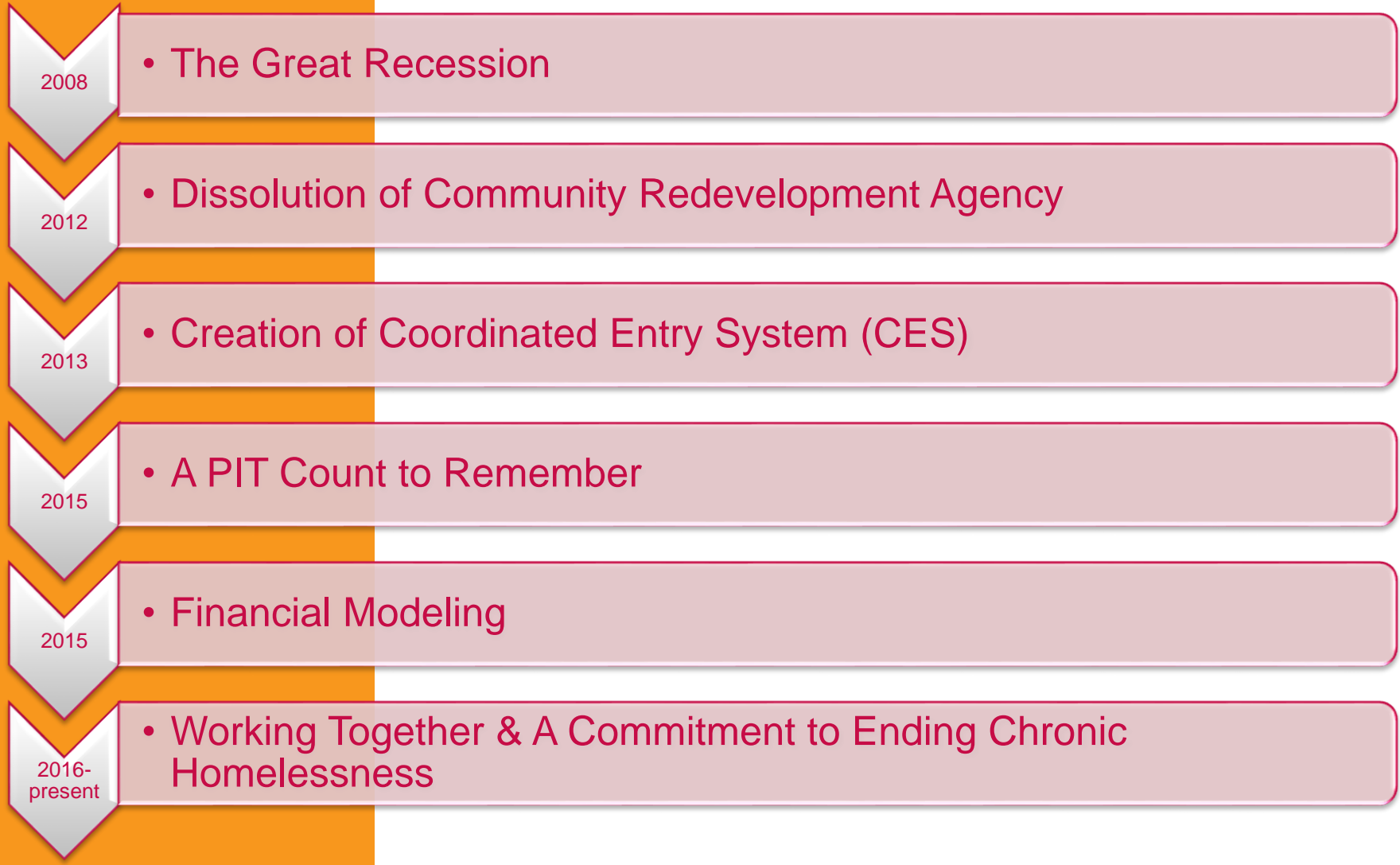


# The Framing: How LA can Assist WA State

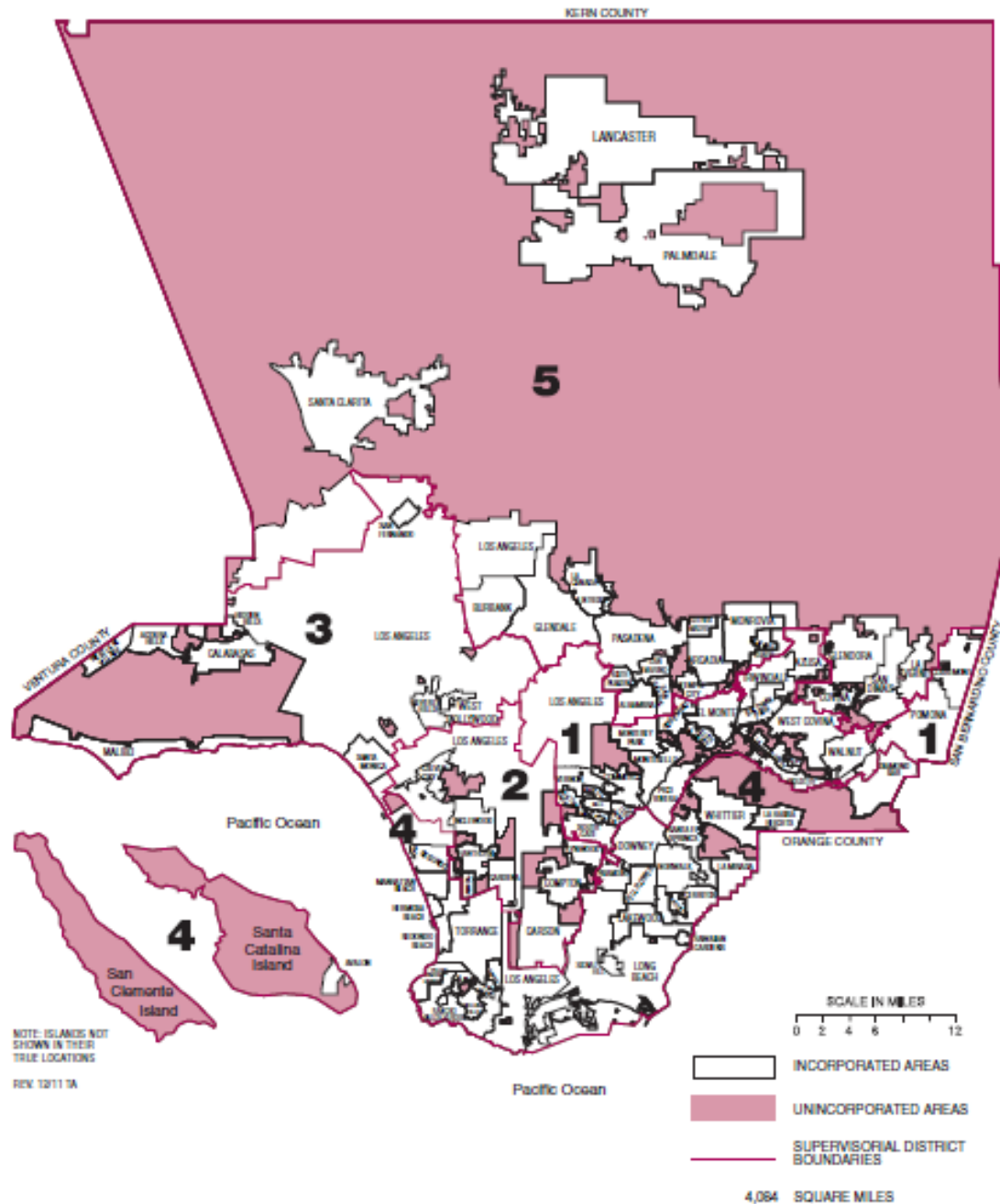

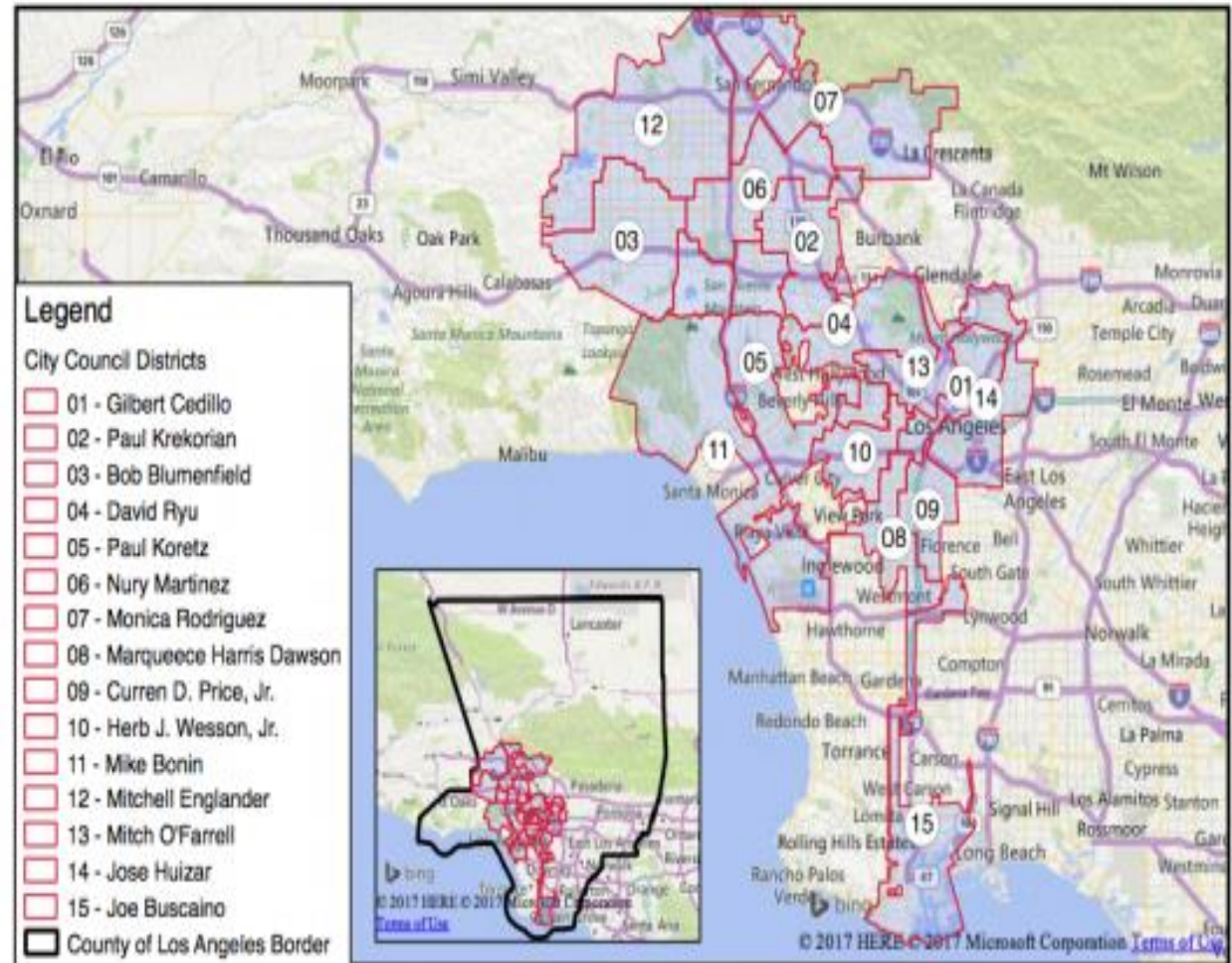

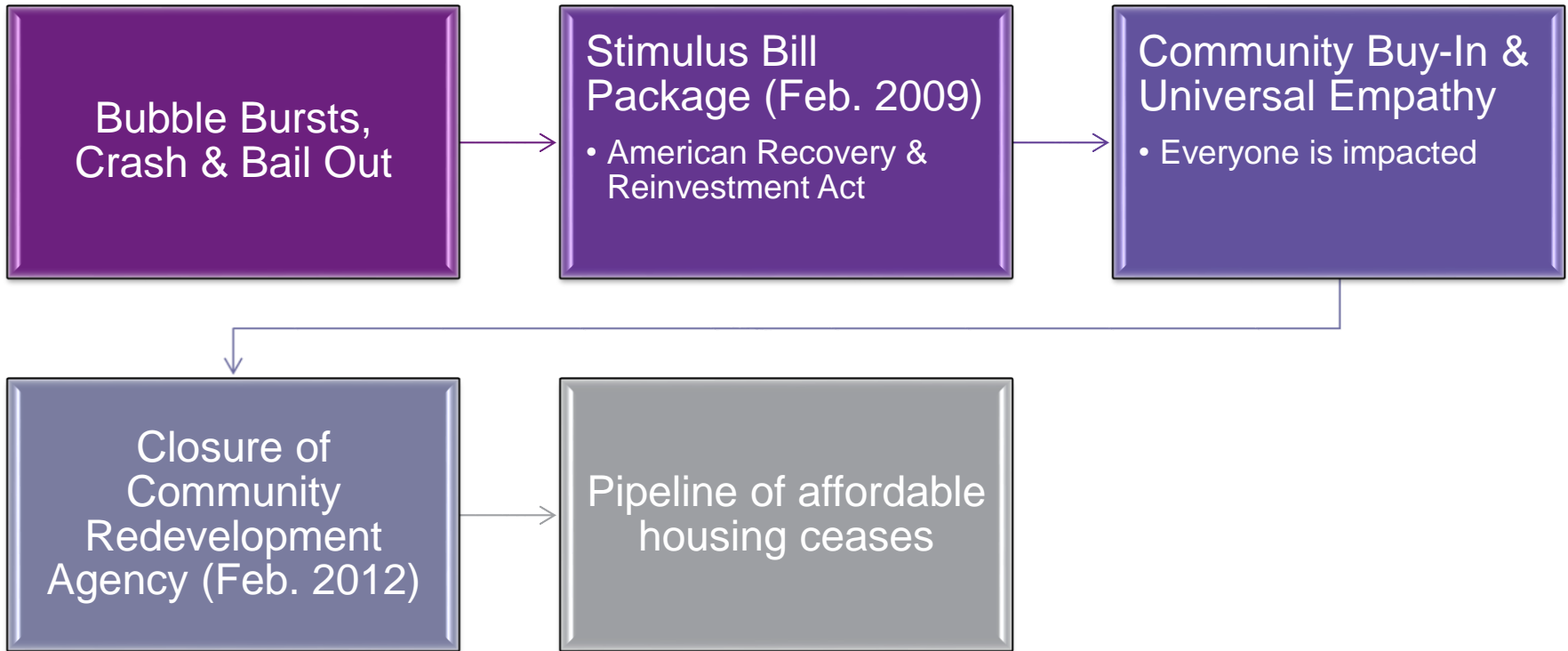

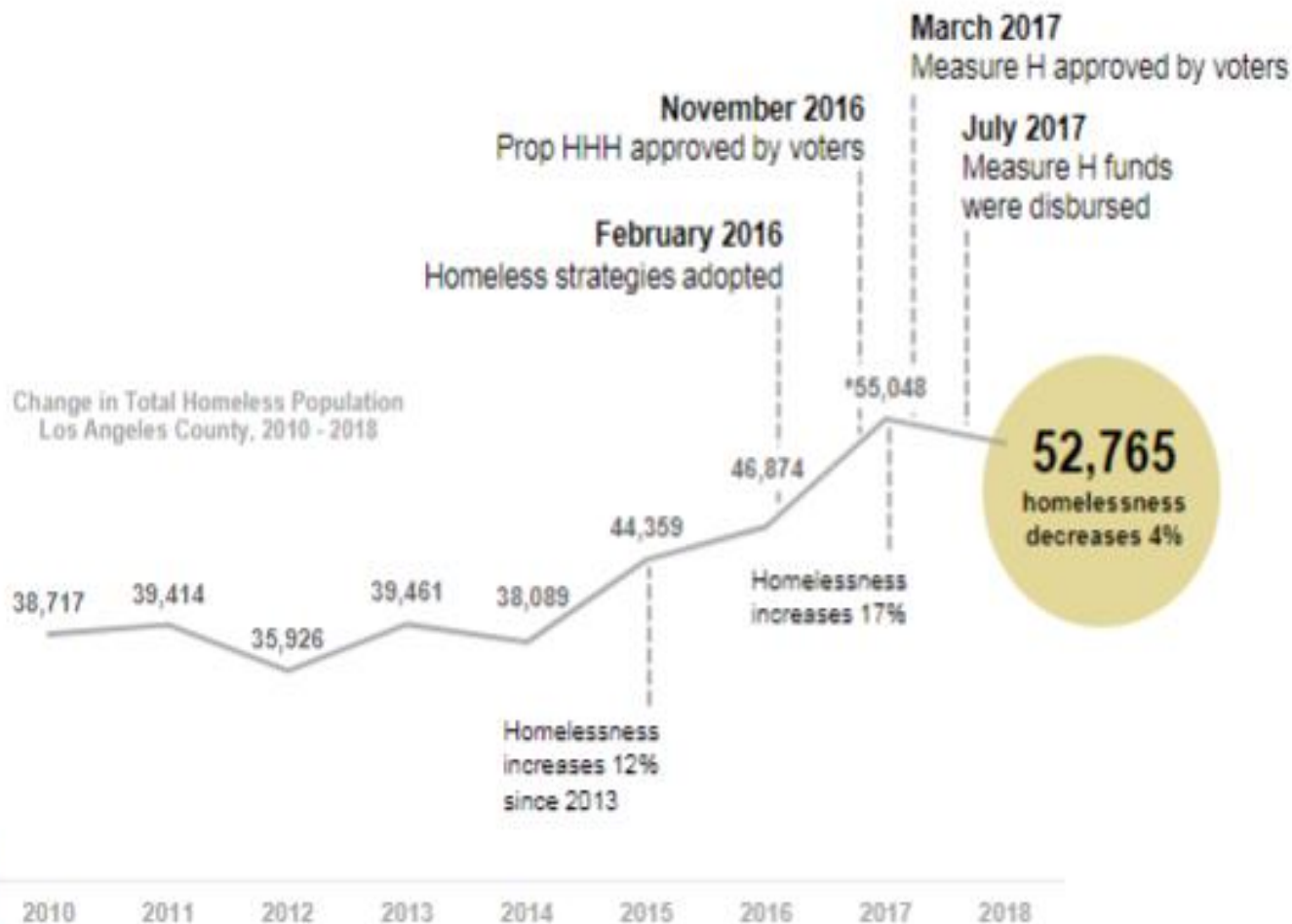

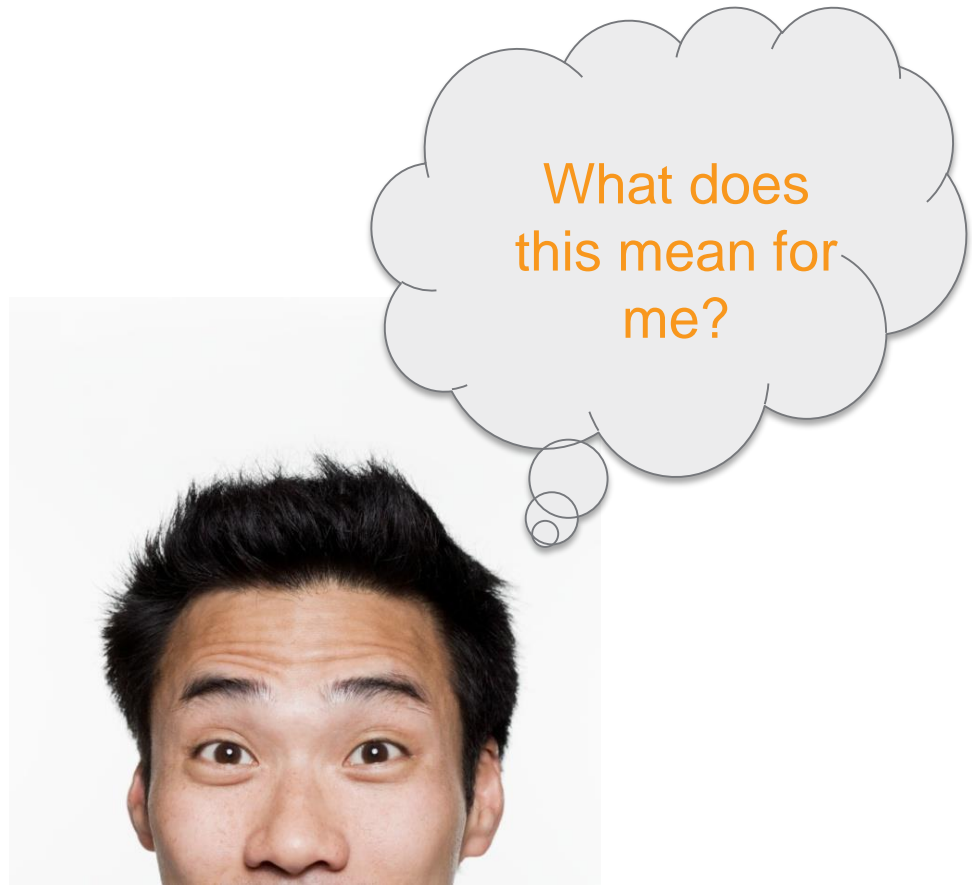


2018 HOMELESS COUNT RESULTS
