Providers working together to improve your care.

Under UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN, network providers—your doctors, nurses, and other health care providers—work with you to improve your health. Together, they take into account the whole picture of your health and track and enhance the care you receive. And, you can self-refer to specialists and other providers in your network.



Convenient access to comprehensive services.

UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN has the most comprehensive services in the Puget Sound region, with more than 6,500 primary and specialty care providers, 18 hospitals, and more than 1,300 clinics and urgent care facilities.

You save money when you use network providers, so if you have specific providers or facilities you want to use, make sure they’re in the network before you enroll.

- + Schedule appointments with network providers, get clinic information, connect with a virtual clinic at no cost to you, and get other services through a single phone number, saving you time.
- + Access a 24/7 nurse care line.
- + Enjoy expanded hours for many primary care and urgent care network providers to serve you outside of regular office hours.



More money in your wallet.

- + You pay \$0 for office visits with primary care and naturopath providers when you see a core network primary care provider or a naturopath from the support network.*
- + No prescription drug deductible.
- + Premiums and the deductible are lower for UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN compared to some of the other UMP plans.
- + UMP Plus–UW Medicine ACN has an out-of-pocket limit of \$2,000 per person or \$4,000 per family for covered benefits.
