



After-Pregnancy Coverage (APC)

Apple Health (Medicaid) After-Pregnancy Coverage (APC) offers services to support your mental, physical, and emotional well-being for 12 months after pregnancy.

Benefits and services

APC offers postpartum follow-up care and provides additional health care services at no cost to you. Benefits include dental care, contraception, preventive care, behavioral health, and other services covered by Apple Health. If you qualify, coverage lasts up to 12 months after your pregnancy ends regardless of a change in income.

Am I eligible?

To be eligible for the APC program you must:

- Have been pregnant within the last 12 months.
- Reside in Washington.
- Have monthly income that meets the standards listed on the back.
- Not be eligible for a different Apple Health program.

Immigration status does not affect eligibility. Learn more at hca.wa.gov/apc.

Are you pregnant and already have Apple Health coverage?

If you already have Apple Health coverage, you will transition to APC when you update your pregnancy status.
